The purpose of this qualification is to recognise the entry-level skills and knowledge required to provide a training pathway for careers in the health and wellbeing sectors. This qualification is targeted at entrants into the health and wellbeing sectors, including those re-entering the workforce. It provides foundation skills to ensure that workers are safe to work at an entry level in a health or wellbeing setting.
